Second Round of “Science Exposition” - Adverse Weather Arrangement

Tropical cyclone Kompasu is expected to strengthen into a severe tropical storm and move to about 400 km from Hong Kong tomorrow, i.e., 13 October 2021. In light of this, after careful considering the inclement weather condition, it is with much regret to announce the following arrangements for the second round of “Science Exposition” scheduled to be held at the Xiqu Centre. The seminars originally scheduled for tomorrow, 13 October 2021, will be CALLED OFF and the exhibition to be held from 13-16 October 2021 will be deferred in order to safeguard the safety of all the participants. Depending on the weather condition after the passing of Kompasu, the exhibition may be held in the latter part of the said period.
